

*December Sess 1866
In Re Lunacy of Daniel Albright*

*The petition of Mary Ann McDonald respectfully represents: that Daniel Albright is an insane person within said county, that he is now confined in the jail of said county on an information and commitment for surety of the peace, that for five years and upwards he has been so far has been so far deprived of his reason and understanding, that he is rendered unfit and unable to govern himself or to manage his affairs, and is so violent at times that it is unsafe for him to be at large—That said Daniel Albright has no estate, that his residence and legal settlement is in Mercer County Pa but now confined in this County: That his friends or relatives are as follows viz: Jane Pierce, Fannie Whyland, Mary Ann McDonald, Elizabeth Laurence and Susan Donaldson daughters, all of this county and Margaret Carr of Washington City, D.C. Joseph Allbright—son of Tennessee, Daniel Allbright of Oil City Pa and Stephen Allbright sons of Pittsburgh Pa—and that they are unable to make provision for the payment of the charges for keeping said Daniel Allbright in a summary way and to commit the said Daniel Allbright to the Western Pennsylvania Hospital Feby 16, 1867.


