



## Philatelic Genealogy: Western Pennsylvania at Work

---

An old envelope can help us imagine our ancestor at work. This article presents six envelopes sent from western Pennsylvania workplaces between 1861 and 1907. The sender and recipient of each envelope are identified in a U. S. census, city directory, or similar source. The pictures on these envelopes add detail and color to occupations shown in the census as manufacturer and merchant. While workplace owners have been identified in this article, these images let us glimpse the life of every employee of these companies.

Prior to 1863 (and in rural areas until after 1900), people picked up their mail at the post office. The address written on an envelope may be the nearest post office and not the recipient's home address.<sup>1</sup> As with any source of genealogical information, old envelopes must be studied in combination with other sources before reaching a conclusion. Four envelopes shown in this article are from philatelic auction catalogs and one envelope is from a postal history vendor website from which *Philgen.org* has permission to use photographs.<sup>2</sup> The author purchased one envelope on eBay® for \$6.

Graff, Bennett and Company, owners of the Clinton Iron and Nail Works in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, sent an envelope to Jonathan McConnell in Grand Rapids, Michigan in 1861. [Figure 1] The owners' full names are shown as John Graff and James E. Bennett in the 1861 Pittsburgh directory, and a John Graff, iron manufacturer, and a James "I. Bennet," manufacturer, are in



Pittsburgh in the 1860 U. S. census.<sup>3</sup> A John McConnell, hardware dealer, is in Grand Rapids in the 1860 U. S. census.<sup>4</sup> The envelope, which is illustrated with a view of the mill, was printed by G. F. Schuchman and Company of Pittsburgh (shown at lower left on the envelope). A George F. Schuchman,

lithographer, is listed in the 1861 Pittsburgh directory and a G. F. Schuchman, artist, is in Pittsburgh in the 1860 U.S. census.<sup>5</sup>

L.W. Olds, “Wholesale Manufacturer of Well & Cistern Pumps from Wild Cucumber Wood” of Erie, Pennsylvania sent an envelope to M. O. Olds of Youngsville, Pennsylvania circa 1865. [Figure 2] A Lewis W. Olds, pump manufacturer, is in Erie, and a Mason O. Olds, pump manufacturer, is in



Youngsville, in the 1870 U. S. census.<sup>6</sup> Online family trees show that Lewis and Mason Olds were first cousins.<sup>7</sup> The envelope has an illustration of a hand pump.

Kent Brothers, “Manufacturers of Kent’s Standard Oil,” of Corry, Pennsylvania (and formerly of Jamestown, New York), sent an envelope



from Corry to M. D. Chapman in Clear Creek, Chautauqua County, New York circa 1865. [Figure 3] An invoice from “Kent Brothers, Manufacturers of Illuminating Oils,” shows them as A. F. and A. M. Kent.<sup>8</sup> An Archibald F. Kent, thirty-eight years old, and Alma M. Kent, twenty-nine years old, are living together in Corry, with both shown as retired dry goods dealers in the 1870 U. S. census, and an Archibald Kent, a gas engineer in Oil City, and an A. M. Kent, a manufacturer in Corry, are in the 1880 U. S. census.<sup>9</sup> A Myron Chapman, merchant, is in Ellington, New York (four miles southeast of Clear

Creek) in the 1870 U. S. census, and he is shown as M. D. Chapman in the 1880 U. S. census.<sup>10</sup> The envelope is illustrated with two barrels of oil.

Coleman, Westerman and Company, owners of the Sharon Rolling Mill in Sharon, Pennsylvania, sent an envelope to C. B. Wick, Jr. in New York City circa 1865. [Figure 4] William Coleman, James Westerman, C. B. Wick, Jr., and P. W. Keller were the mill owners in the early 1860s, and a James Westerman, iron monger, is in Youngstown, Ohio (eight miles southwest of Sharon) in the 1860 U. S. census.<sup>11</sup> The envelope is illustrated with a view of the mill.



in 1885. [Figure 5] Thomas C. Jenkins, a wholesale merchant, is in Pittsburgh in the 1880 U. S. census, and he is listed in the 1884 Pittsburgh directory as a wholesale grocer, in both cases living at 44 Union Avenue.<sup>12</sup>



Graff and Firth manufactured woolen goods in Worthington, and a Peter Graff and an Isaac Firth, both woolen manufacturers, are in Worthington in the 1870 U. S. census.<sup>13</sup> The envelope has an illustration of a four-story storefront.

J. Bickart of Donora, Pennsylvania sent an envelope to A. T. Dietz in Toledo, Ohio in 1907. [Figure 6] The picture on the envelope shows the front window of "Bickart's Confectionery & Ice Cream Parlor." A Jacob "Bickhart,"

confectioner, is in Donora in the 1910 U. S. census.<sup>14</sup> An A. T. Dietz, manufacturer of ice cream cones and ice cream cone ovens, is listed in the



1907 Toledo directory with a work address matching the street address written on the envelope.<sup>15</sup> An Andrew T. Dietz, “brick” manufacturer, is in Toledo in the 1910 U. S. census, although Andrew T. Dietz continues to be shown in the 1910 and 1912 Toledo directories for ice cream cone ovens.<sup>16</sup>

Twelve other work-related envelopes from western Pennsylvania can be seen on *Philgen.org* (search on family name or city): David Barnhart (dry goods, Pleasant Unity, Westmoreland County); Job C. Bartlett (stoves, Pittsburgh); William M. Brinker (grocer and confectioner, Wilkinsburg, Allegheny

County); Samuel W. Craft (undertaker, California, Washington County); William K. Gillespie (wholesale grocer, Pittsburgh); R and W Jenkinson (cigars, Pittsburgh); Johnson, Eayge and Earl (tobacco, Pittsburgh); James H. Johnston (guns and pistols, Pittsburgh); Ray F. Livermore (dry goods, Corry); and Seaman, Sleeth and Black (roll works, Pittsburgh). The author requests reader assistance in locating two senders in a census, city directory, or similar source: F. P. Adams (beef, veal, and mutton, Connellsville, Fayette County) and P. L. Kenny (furs, Enon, Washington County). Data provided by readers for any item will be credited to the person and/or their genealogical, historical, or philatelic association.

This article shows how old envelopes illustrate our ancestor's life at work. Postal historians refer to these envelopes as advertising covers, and published references show hundreds of other examples.<sup>17</sup> In addition to life at work, old envelopes and postcards can also reveal an immigrant's home village, military service details, social and political interests, and even family photographs on a real photo postcard.<sup>18</sup> Please contact the author if you have an envelope or postcard that you would like to share on *Philgen.org*, the philatelic genealogy website and database.

The following names were abstracted from the *Physicians' and Dentists' Directory of the State of Pennsylvania...* (Philadelphia: Galen Gonsier & Co, 1902). The book is on microfilm at Carnegie Library of Pittsburgh.

The information included in the following article includes the name of the doctor, office address (if given), school attended and year of graduation. There is often additional information on physicians, such as other schools attended, internships, and memberships in medical societies.

**QUARTERLY:** Published continuously since 1974. Contains scholarly articles, abstracts, and other materials about the 26 counties in Western Pennsylvania (map inside front cover). The articles are indexed in the Periodical Source Index (PERSI), available online through Heritage Quest, on CD-Rom and in print form in many large libraries. Back issues from Volume 25 to date can be purchased, subject to availability, for \$5.00 per issue, plus \$3.00 p/h. Volumes 1 through 5 are available on the members only section of our website and later volumes will continue to be added. Address correspondence to the Quarterly Editor at the Society address.

**NEWSLETTER:** *Jots from the Point* is issued bimonthly and contains news of current genealogical happenings, member activities, synopsis of WPGS meetings, and other Society news. Address correspondence to the Jots editor at the Society address.
