



New Castle Female Seminary and New Castle Academy

Part I: New Castle Female Seminary — Mercer and Beaver Counties

New Castle Female Seminary was chartered in 1838. There was no Lawrence County at the time; the Beaver–Mercer County line passed through New Castle. An active promoter and organizer of the institution was evangelist and gospel music composer, Ira D. Sankey. Sankey was a close associate of Dwight Moody. The organizers authorized the sale of one thousand shares of capital stock at five dollars each. Revenue raised in this fashion enabled the trustees to construct a building. The following year the Seminary received the first in a series of annual grants from the State Legislature. Among the Seminary's administrative leaders were Dr. Charles T. Whippo and Messers. Joseph Ketler, John Hewett, Marsh and Bowman. Ketler left to become affiliated with the New Castle Classical and Mathematical Institute. Trustees included Ira Sankey, Henry Pearson, Ezekial Sankey, John Reynolds and Dr. Joseph Pollock.

This compiler has only scant information about the school. In spite of its name we know for sure that it was not preparing young females for the ministry. The culture of the times (1830s and 40s) tells us that much. The function of the typical male secondary school of this era was to prepare individuals for higher education, but where could a New Castle girl go to college? Nowhere, or at least nowhere within a reasonable distance. Oberlin College, Ohio was the first coeducational institution in the nation (1838). Nearby Westminster College was co-educational from the start (1852). There

were no bona-fide female colleges in the region. So what was the curriculum or purpose? This compiler may be able to provide some clues but has no definitive answer.

The commencement/recital program in hand indicates study of English grammar, written arithmetic, oral arithmetic, French, spelling and defining, astronomy, natural philosophy, New Testament and music. Male secondary schools of the era would have offered some of the same subjects plus a heavy dose of Latin and Greek needed for college admission. French was considered the language of culture and sophistication. This suggests that New Castle Female Seminary may have been a "finishing school." The reader should be the judge.

The roster for the Seminary comes from an examination/recital program dated April 28, 1842. At least partly because of New Castle's placement on the Mercer-Beaver County line it would require a tremendous amount of labor to determine the residence of each individual. Considering horse and buggy was the mode of transportation at the time and because families sheltered their daughters, it is reasonable to hypothesize that the students lived in the greater New Castle area. That means southern Mercer County or northern Beaver County in the 1830s and 40s. An alphabetical listing of participants is below.

In the 1840s the Commonwealth ceased giving grants to private secondary schools and the Seminary closed.

Part II: New Castle Academy— Lawrence County

The closing of the Seminary brought forth a new group of entrepreneurs who rented the Seminary facilities to operate a co-educational secondary school that may have become New Castle Academy. It was operated successively by Messers. Bartlet and Copeland and Rev. R. Audley Browne. Rev. Browne later served as president of Westminster College. The opening date for the academy is unknown but considering that it had several leaders before the 1851–52 school year it could have been the mid–1840s. The Academy had its own building under construction in 1852.

Martin Gantz became a prominent New Castle educator, In the 1870s he was on the faculty of New Castle College. He served as New Castle City School Superintendent and a district school was subsequently named in his honor.

The 1851-2 program of studies included orthography, reading, penmanship, arithmetic, geography, English grammar, algebra, geometry, physiology, natural philosophy, book-keeping, drawing, Latin, declamation, composition, vocal music and piano music.

Lawrence County was created in 1849 with New Castle as the county seat. Considering the horse and buggy transportation of the era it is probably safe to conclude that the students enrolled at the New Castle Academy resided in New Castle or nearby. However, we cannot rule out the possibility that a few may have arrived by rail or canal.

A Short History of the Pennsylvania Canal, Western Division, and the Boatman's Association

Construction of the Pennsylvania Canal started near Harrisburg in July 1826. A correspondent for the *Adams Sentinel* newspaper stated the entire canal was 270 mile in length, had 40 aqueducts, 175 locks, 28 dams, 2 tunnels, and nearly 300 bridges. The western division portion of the canal from Johnstown to Pittsburgh ran 105 miles and had 64 locks that lifted the canal 465 feet, 16 aqueducts, and a tunnel 900 feet long. The canal's average dimensions were four feet in depth, 40 feet wide on top and tapered to 28 feet wide on the bottom. Hundreds of workers (largely Irish immigrants) dug the canal bed by hand or cut stone for the numerous aqueducts and bridges.

A laborer was expected to dig the equivalent of 3 feet of canal per day. During construction, workers were rationed 4 drinks of whiskey each day that was distributed by the water boys. About 1828, Father Demetrius Gallitzin offered Mass at Blairsville and at the Canal Tunnel about seven miles below Blairsville to the immigrants involved in canal construction. The canal was completely opened to traffic from Philadelphia to Pittsburg in 1834. Total construction cost to the owner, the State of Pennsylvania, was estimated to be \$50,000,000.

Canal Commerce

The first canal packet boats did not reach Blairsville until July 22, 1829. A report on canal traffic for the period November 19, to December 20, 1828 stated that 1360 barrels of salt had gone west and 6 steam engines had gone east through the Kiskiminetas Line to Dam #1. In 1833 the port of Huntingdon shipped 6 million tons of freight on canal boats. During this period, the packets traveled at about 3 miles per hour, and the trip from

Philadelphia to Pittsburg took six days, traveling night and day with frequent changes of horses or mules. A typical actual time schedule for the David Leech Packet Line is displayed on the facing page. Some canal boat lines operated on Sunday, but others did not. T. S. Reid commented that the Union Line of Blairsville “would not allow their captains to run later on Sabbath nights than eleven o’clock, nor to start earlier than one o’clock on Monday morning.” After the great flood of 1838, generally known as the big break in the Canal, boating was stopped for an entire season due to broken dams. The canal offered an improved mode of travel for passengers and reduced the cost of freight.

Commercially, the canal proved a boon to many adjacent communities. Soft coal was shipped in large quantities to Pittsburgh to be used as fuel at its factories. Salt evaporated from scores of salt wells along the Conemaugh and Kiskiminetas Rivers was transported east destined for eastern markets and Cuba. Even silver was shipped on the canal for the federal government from Pittsburgh to the Philadelphia Mint. Saltsburg became the boat-building center for the Canal in 1836. Between 1829 and 1850, hundreds of canal boats were produced.

Hundreds of thousands of recent immigrants used the canal for travel westward. The most famous person to travel the Canal was Charles Dickens in 1842. He wrote “The washing accommodations were primitive. There was a tin ladle chained to the deck, with which every gentleman who thought it necessary to cleanse himself, fished the “dirty” water out of the canal and poured it into a tin basin secured in like manner. There was also a jack towel hanging up before a little looking glass in the bar; in the immediate vicinity of the bread and cheese were a public comb and hairbrush.” “And yet, despite these oddities, even they had, for at least some, a humor of their own, there was much in the mode of traveling which I heartily enjoyed at the time and look back upon with much pleasure.” It was reported that the Vice President of the United States, George Dallas traveled by canal packet boat in 1847 from Blairsville to Johnstown.

In 1856 completion of a single track of the Pennsylvania Railroad started the decline of the Canal. The Canal was sold to the Pennsylvania Railroad in 1857 for \$7,500,000. The Canal was in service 34 years. The Canal from Johnstown to Blairsville was abandoned in May 1862, from Blairsville to Leechburg in 1863; and Leechburg to Pittsburg in 1864.

Canal Occupations

The majority of canal workers were boat crews. Among a boat crew were captains, mule drivers, cooks, bowmen, steersmen, and clerks. It was common that multiple-family members were employed. Boat crews ranged

from a single steersman and a driver to the large passenger vessels with a cook, porter or steward, two steersmen, and two drivers with 2 teams of three mules each. Lock tenders operated the locks which permitted boats to change elevation. A typical lock was 15 feet wide by 90 feet in length. Lock tenders were on duty during all hours of operation. They were given a house adjacent to the lock rent-free. They could also supplement their modest salary by operating small stores and taking in laundry. Company officials required the lock tenders to record all boats passing and at what time. Recording time permitted detection of captains breaking the speed limit. Toll collectors and company clerks worked in offices that were located at weigh-locks and canal terminals. They collected the fees paid by boat captains and maintained boat traffic records.

Reminisces by canal workers

Winfield Hanna recollects as a horse boy on the canal walking on the tow path, making trips in the evening from Springdale to Allegheny City from about 5PM until 1 AM aboard the canal boat "Farmer's Friend". Later, he was driver of the two horses that hauled the "Colonel Lemon" between Pittsburgh and Oil City. Their boat could carry 600 barrels of crude oil. The trip down took 2-1/2 days, the trip up two weeks.

James Layton was a water boy during construction of canal, progressing to cabin boy, then driver of a freighter, driver of 3 horses pulling a passenger packet, to Captain and finally owner of a line of canal boats.

Andrew Kimmel The first money he ever earned was during the construction of the PA canal, when he industriously pushed a wheelbarrow for 50 cents per day.

Matthew Wiley recalled the time when the United States government used to ship silver from New Orleans to New York, Philadelphia, and Boston. It was conveyed by steamboat from New Orleans to Pittsburgh, where it was transferred to the Pennsylvania canal and taken through Johnstown and on east. On one occasion, a keg was held up in a Pittsburgh warehouse for a year or more before the government began to make inquiry about it. It resembled a keg of nails, but it contained silver and was being conveyed from Louisiana to the Philadelphia Mint.

Western Pennsylvania Canal Boatman's Association

The Canal Boatman's Association was in existence from 1885 to about 1917. Its members were generally former employees of the state of Pennsylvania who worked on the western division of Pennsylvania Canal — starting at the Portage Railroad in Cambria County and ending in Pittsburgh. For additional information I would suggest consulting The State Archives of Pennsylvania Manuscript Group (MG) 110.

Members were mainly from Allegheny, Armstrong, Westmoreland, Indiana, Cambria, and Blair counties. The Association's main purpose was fraternal. They organized large annual reunions. The first reunion was held in 1885 at Ninevah, Pennsylvania.

At the 1889 reunion it was reported that all the records of the association, including their membership rolls, were lost in the 1889 flood. Ironically, the cause of the flood was the failure of the dam on the south fork of the Conemaugh River— constructed to supply water to the Canal during the dry season.

The Reunions in the early days consisted of speeches, a band, a parade, and excursions to local sights. Membership in 1895 was 226, 240 in 1902, and 128 in 1911.

In conjunction with the compiled list in Table I, a search for people who claimed occupations associated with water transportation was conducted using the 1850 US Federal Census Population Returns. The search included all those enumerated in the towns, boroughs, and townships bordering the Western Division Canal, the Kittanning feeder canal, and the associated rivers. The results are tabulated in Table II (see following pages), consisting of 1159 names with age, occupation, county and city/township, dwelling number, and Ancestry image page number.
