



Part II should be considered a new beginning, i.e., the names of students who were listed in the last year of Part I may appear again in the first year of this section. Thereafter an effort has been made to avoid repetition of names. Since the length of the program was elevated to a three year program, the number "2" will be used to indicate that enrollment as a first year student was followed the next year by enrollment as a second year student. A "3" after the name of a second year student indicates enrollment the next year as a third year student.

If the academic year is repeated or the next occurrence is two or more years later the name will reappear. A "2, 3" implies enrollment for the second and third years consecutively. If a student died during the following year, the name will appear both years. All residences are Pennsylvania unless otherwise noted. Institutional terminology is used throughout.

---

**T**he General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania enacted a law regarding enrollment in the militia.<sup>1</sup>

Section 1: Be it enacted, &c., That every able-bodied male citizen, resident within this State, of the age of twenty-one years and under the age of forty-five years, excepting officers and enlisted men in the National Guard, and persons exempted by this act and excepting idiots, lunatics, common drunkards, vagabonds, paupers and persons convicted of any infamous crime, shall be enrolled in the militia; and person so convicted, after enrollment, shall be forthwith dropped from the roll.

Section 2: In addition to the persons absolutely exempted from enrollment in the militia by the laws of the United States, the following persons are exempted from military duty, namely: The members of the Legislature and the officers thereof, the Secretary of the Commonwealth, Attorney General, State Treasurer, Secretary of Internal Affairs, Auditor General, State Librarian, Superintendent of Common Schools, and all the judges of the several courts of this Commonwealth, sheriff, recorder of deeds, register of wills, prothonotary, district attorney, and clerks of the courts of this Commonwealth.
