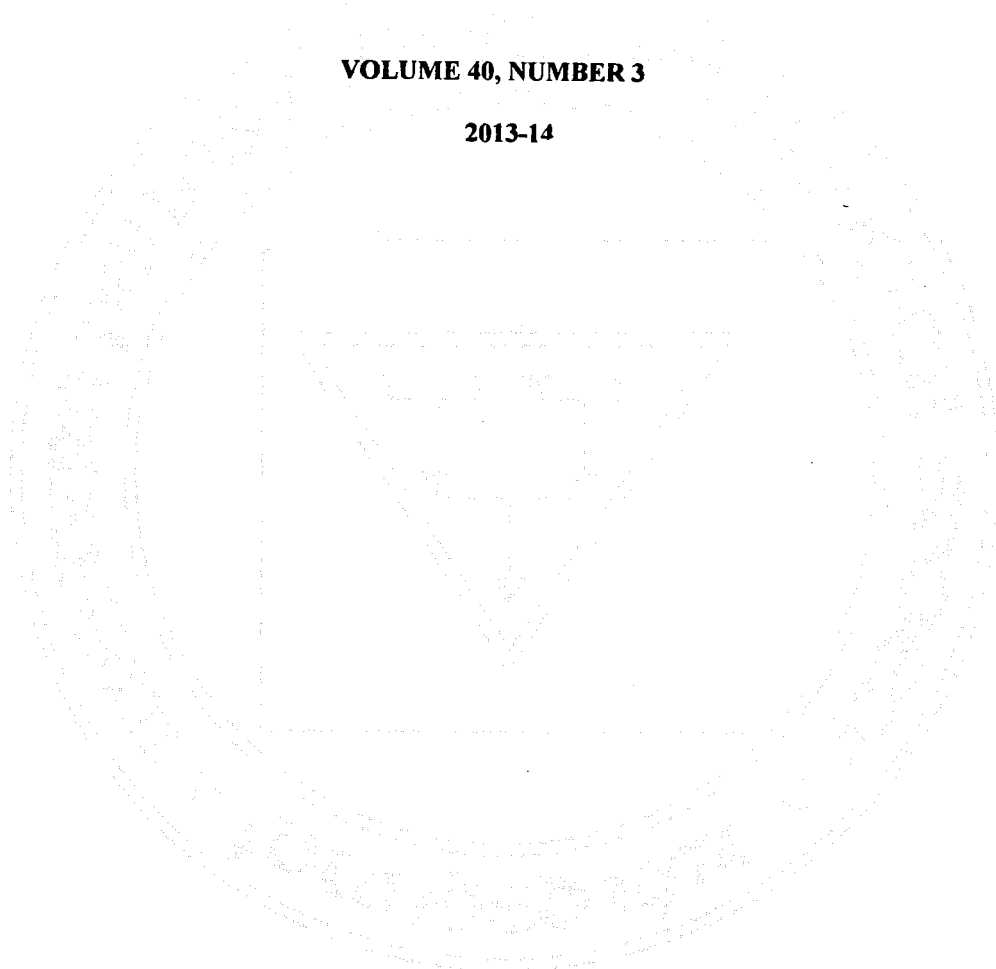

Fredonia Normal Academy and Fredonia Institute Part I: 1886 to 1893-94

Fredonia, a village of about 600 people (1890's), is located midway between Mercer and Greenville. The community had daily rail service. The institute claimed "The healthfulness is unsurpassed."

The genealogy of the Institute appears to be select school, Normal Academy and Institute. The opening date for the Normal Academy is uncertain. It appears that the institution had its beginnings as a select school established in 1886. This was followed in 1887 by the opening of Fredonia Normal Academy. The Academy issued an 1887 catalog. It appears to cover the year 1886-87. This catalog contains a roster of students for that year plus a roster for the previous spring. The charter for Fredonia Institute was recorded at the Mercer County Courthouse in 1889. What is labeled as Fredonia Institute's First Catalog is dated 1891. The select school, academy and Institute probably all used the same facilities.

The rosters for the Academy and Fredonia Institute have been taken from annual catalogs. Except for the Academy, catalog rosters will be edited to avoid some duplication. The rosters will be presented in four parts. Part I of this paper includes names for Fredonia Normal Academy, shareholders listed in the Institute's charter and student names from the early years of the Institute; Part II covers the years 1894-95 to 1897-98; Part-III 1898-99 to 1907-08 and Part V 1908-09 to 1912-13. Throughout all parts of this manuscript the place of residence is Pennsylvania unless otherwise noted.

The Normal Academy Catalog of 1887 lists students for that academic year plus those who attended for ten weeks during the previous spring. The reader is reminded that the word "Normal" used in this context refers to a secondary school level program for the preparation of elementary school teachers. Following are the rosters.

Like so many institutions of this era the Institute asserted that its building was "commodious." The Institute's library was funded by Andrew Carnegie. It proclaimed to offer "MAXIMUM ADVANTAGE AT MINIMUM EXPENSE." As was usual for the era, the precursors of fraternities, literary societies and debating societies were fostered. The Institute endorsed the Athenian educational model, "A sound mind in a sound body." Studies took precedence but the Institute encouraged participation in activities such as croquet, tennis, football, baseball and skating. It also fielded a baseball team that competed with other institutions of its kind, i.e., Volant College. It fielded a team comprised of both faculty and students.

The Institute issued a circular for the year 1899-90. It lists faculty but contains no student rosters. Since the 1890-91 catalog is titled the *First Catalog*, the compiler is assuming the circular was for advertising purposes.

The 1890-91 catalog simply lists students by gender. Subsequent catalogs list them by academic program.

Inmates of St. Peter's Orphans' Home Allegheny City, Pennsylvania

St. Peter's Evangelical Lutheran Orphans' Home was founded by the first pastor of St. Peter's Church, Rev. W. F. Schaefer. An Orphan Aid Society was organized in 1895 to raise funds to purchase land and build the orphanage. Four individuals pledged a total of \$2000 for the land—Leonard Wagner; Mrs. Buente, Mr. Wagner's mother; Henry Blumhage; and Charles Merker. Building began in July 1896 and the dedication took place in January 1897¹.

The first matron of the home was Sister Johanna Heinrichs, who became a deaconess after her husband's death. She served for 17 years and died on February 25, 1914. Mrs. Katherine Hess, formerly in charge of the kitchen, was elected matron. Two helpers in the home were Elsie Ehni, who entered the Home as an orphan in December 1918 and Mrs. Naylor, who came in January 1928.
