ORMSBY, JANE—August 5th, at her residence near Clarksville, Pa., in the 65th year of her age. Wife of Maj. J. W. Ormsby. 2 Sep 1873

TROWBRIDGE, FLORA—at her residence in Chesterville, Morrow County, Ohio, August 19th, of laryngeal consumption. Wife of Samuel Trowbridge, in the 28th year of her age. 2 Sep 1873

BERRYVILLE, FLORA C.—August 20th; in her 26th year. Daughter of Alex Berryhill of Burgettstown. 10 Sep 1873

FARIS, MRS. ELIZABETH—June 23rd; in the 77th year of her age. Daughter of Archibald McDonald. She was born in Washington County; removed to Ohio County, Virginia at age fifteen. Married to Wm. Faris at age 21 and was the mother of twelve children. Two sons became ministers, John M. and Wm. B., who died while pastor of church at Noga, Illinois. 10 Sep 1873

MCDONALD, CHARLES RANALD—at Bangkok, Siam on June 29th, of cholera. Only son of Rev. N. A. and Eliza D. McDonald; aged 9 years, 5 months, and 12 days. 10 Sep 1873

Clarksville Academy

Mercer County

The community of Clarksville is located in southwestern Mercer County. The earliest settlers arrived around 1800. When the Erie Extension of the Pennsylvania Canal was operational the community enjoyed a modest degree of prosperity through the shipment of coal. When the Canal closed the prosperity disappeared. Not much is known about the opening, operating or closing of Clarksville Academy. According to his biography, Samuel C. Koonce (listed in the program below) attended a public school, Clarksville Academy and then in 1860 went to Duff's Iron City College (Pittsburgh). We might imply that he attended the Academy for more than one year before going to Duff's, hence the Academy may have been operating a few years earlier, perhaps 1857 or 58. An advertisement for the Clarksville Select School appears in an 1885 issue of *The Mercer Dispatch*. Names in the advertisement are Eliza and Mary Dickson, principals; D. A. Newell, president; and Wm. Koonce, secretary. There is no evidence to confirm or refute that this is the same institution. The closing date is unknown.

Findley Township Voter Lists

Among the Hays papers that survived in my family were two voter lists. One is from an election held 14 October 1828 in Findlay Township, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania. The other is for the presidential election of 1836, presumably also held in Findlay Township. Martin van Buren, a Democrat, won. It is one of the more unusual elections ever held in the United States. The Whig Party ran four different candidates in different sections of the county hoping that the sum of number of electors for the four would exceed that for van Buren. The tactic did not work.

The original lists were donated to the Historical Society of Western Pennsylvania which was incorporated into the Heinz History Center.


